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Stakeholder Feedback Analysis on Curriculum 2023-2024

Students Feedback Analysis

- 1) 16% of students felt that size of syllabus in term of student load is high.
- 2) 21% of students feel that some of course objectives are not clear.
- 3) 14% of students are not satisfied with credits allotted for the lab session.
- 4) 17% of students feel that syllabus of courses moderate to career oriented
- 5) 9% of students reported that total syllabus is not covered in classes.

Teachers Feedback Analysis

- 1) 14% of faculty feels that books prescribed/listed as reference materials are not relevant, they must beupdated.
- 2) 15% of faculty suggests that they needed relevance of study in latest/future technologies.
- 3) 14 % of faculty suggests that the syllabus is not well organized
- 4) 13% of faculty suggests for the update of optional papers as electives.

Alumni feedback

- 1) 15% of alumni student suggest for the syllabus updating.
- 2) 24% of alumni student suggest that the course skill required by the industry was moderate.
- 3) 11% of alumni student suggest that syllabus does not create interest to Purse post-graduation.
- 4) 20% of alumni student suggest that curriculum is moderate of relevance to job

Employers Feedback Analysis

- 1) 26% of Employer suggests that syllabus was not meeting the expectations of the industry.
- 2) 36% of employer suggests that the elective given in the curriculum does not fulfill the advancement in latest technologies
- 3) 26% of the employer suggests that the students require proficiency in advanced concepts.
- 4) 14% of employer suggests the student need to develop the skills to work with team s

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ACTION TAKEN

- 1. To fill the gap in the syllabus, acting CO and learn content beyond syllabus at part with present market trends all students are encouraged to attend the certificate program and value added course.
- 2. Students are advised to undergo online training programs, online internship/field projects, field visit to correlate the syllabus and solve real world problems.
- 3. The CAC committee suggests that a letter of representation to JNTUK be initiated to express inadequacy in the syllabus to meet current industry trends and also review the textbooks and reference books in relevance to curriculum.
- **4.** The CAC committee also suggests that each subject last unit shall be included the approach to implement real world problems in the syllabus in next regulation.
- **5.** The CAC suggests that the department shall conduct entrepreneurship /startup skill program in various domain based on the requirement of the stakeholders.
- **6.** To enter into MOU with various industries to improve the interaction between the academia and industry sector.

A REPORT ON 2023-24 STUDENTS FEEDBACK

For any educational institute students are the backbones. The interest and participation of students at all levels in both the internal quality assurance and external quality assurance have to play a central role. Their academic result makes a changeover of the college situation. Here, in our institution we used to take the feedback for every completing year regarding the academics, syllabus, and way of teaching from the students. For the academic year 2023-2024 we took the feedback from nearly 291 students from ECE department. Here we are giving brief disclosure about how the feedback followed.

Actually we had given 8 questions in a sheet of feedback and the response of them for each and every question is detailed below

- 1. Most of the students have the opinion that the syllabus of courses that they have studied is in relation to applicability/relevance to real life situations (159 out of 291)
- 2. The present curriculum's depth of the course contents is moderate while compare with other factors.(177 out of 291).
- 3. From the total students of our department most of the students are satisfied with syllabus coverage in the class. (175 out of 291)
- 4. In students opinion for the rating given by major students on extent of effort required by students on syllabus is high. (157 out of 291)
- 5. It is also observed that the students offering of the electives in terms of their relevance to the specialization streams are satisfied. (155 out of 291)
- 6. The satisfaction levels of the students on learning objects stated for each of the course is moderate. (149 out of 291)
- 7. The allocation of the credits to the courses is satisfactory (152 out of 291)
- 8. Moreover, it has also be observed that the overall structure of syllabus for the program is highly satisfied (164 out of 291)

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


- 1. Most of the students accepted that the syllabus was updated enough to specify the real life situations.
